



**NON-MEDICARE OUTPATIENT OBSERVATION NOTICE
(NOON)**

You're a hospital outpatient receiving observation services. You are not an inpatient because:

- Based on your hospital course, your doctor will determine if a change to inpatient status becomes warranted.
- Your doctor does not expect your hospital stay to be two overnights (two midnights.)

Being an outpatient may affect what you pay in a hospital:

It is important for you to understand that as an outpatient, you may be responsible for any out of pocket expenses, such as co-payments, deductibles, medications including self-administered medications, other pharmaceutical supplies.

Observation services may affect coverage and payment of your care after you leave the hospital:
