(the "Advocate Health JOC") to manage and oversee an integrated health care delivery and academic system known as Advocate Health. The Atrium Health Enterprise was created in October 2020 when the Authority, which directly and through its affiliates does business as Atrium Health, and the Wake Forest Baptist Health system ("Wake Forest Baptist"), including Wake Forest School of Medicine, became part of a single enterprise pursuant to a health system integration agreement and related agreements. Governance of the Atrium Health Enterprise is provided by the board of directors of Atrium Health, Inc., which has delegated many of its governance responsibilities to the Advocate Health JOC Board pursuant to the Advocate Health JOA.
